

DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT TO THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON THE EUROPEAN CHARTER FOR RESEARCHERS AND THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCHERS

The Ramón y Cajal Health Research Institute (IRYCIS), fully supports the Commission Recommendation on the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers.

IRYCIS follows the stated principles for the recruitment of researchers.
